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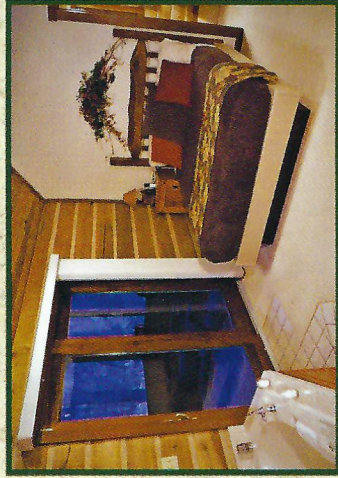

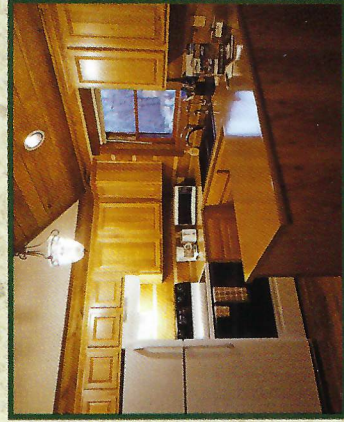
At Cabins & Candlelight,

Our cabins are built with real logs, which provide a warm and comfortable feel that you simply can't get from modern day materials.

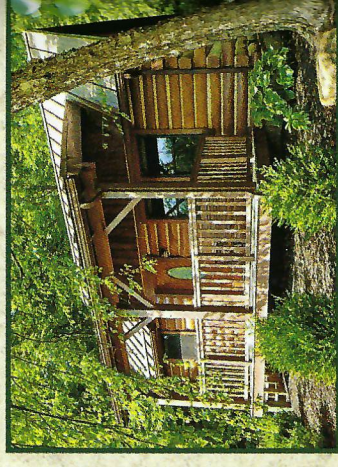
That's where the similarities with the Abe Lincoln era end, however, and modern day, upscale luxuries take over. Each cabin boasts pampering amenities such as:
